




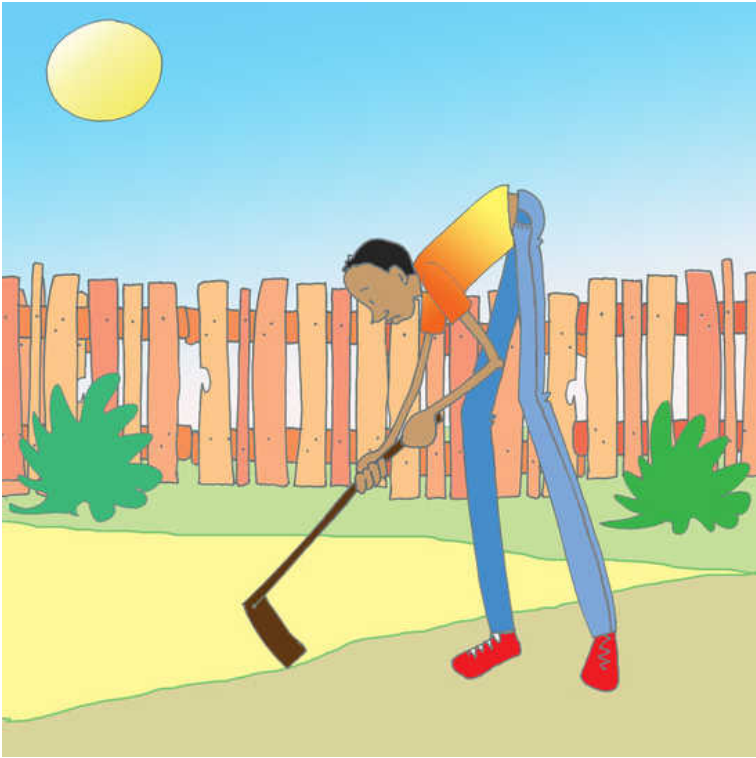

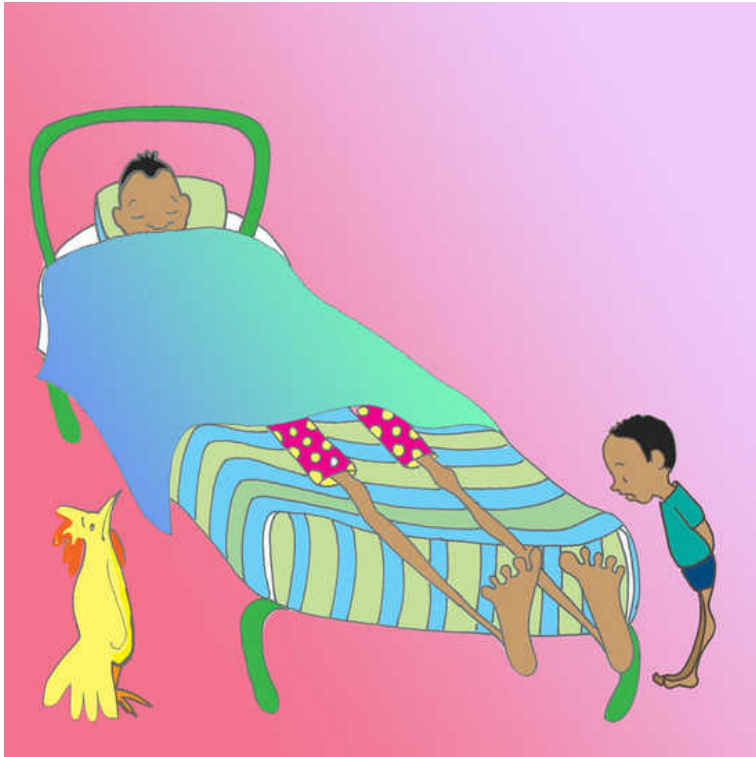
His hoe was too short.

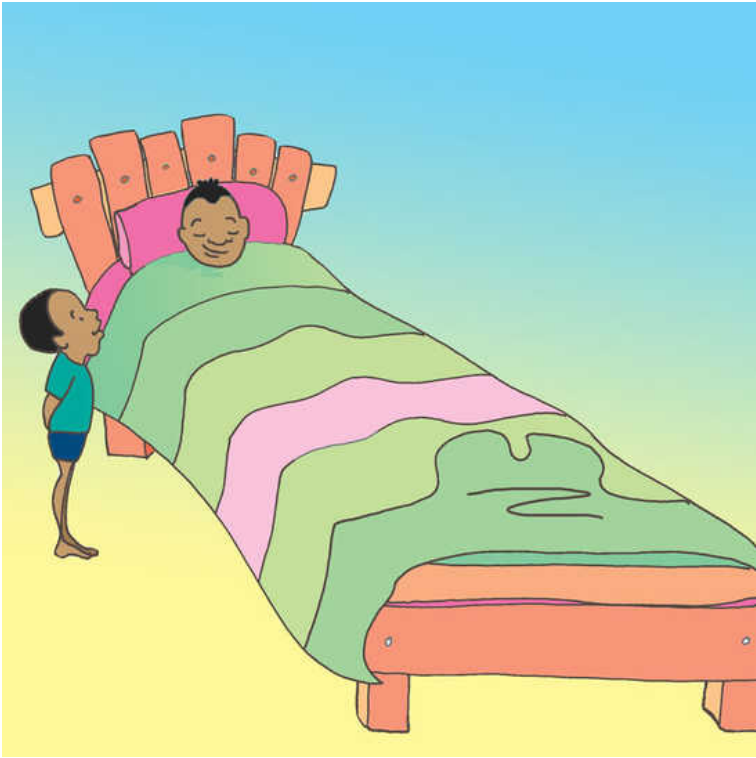
He made a very long hoe handle.

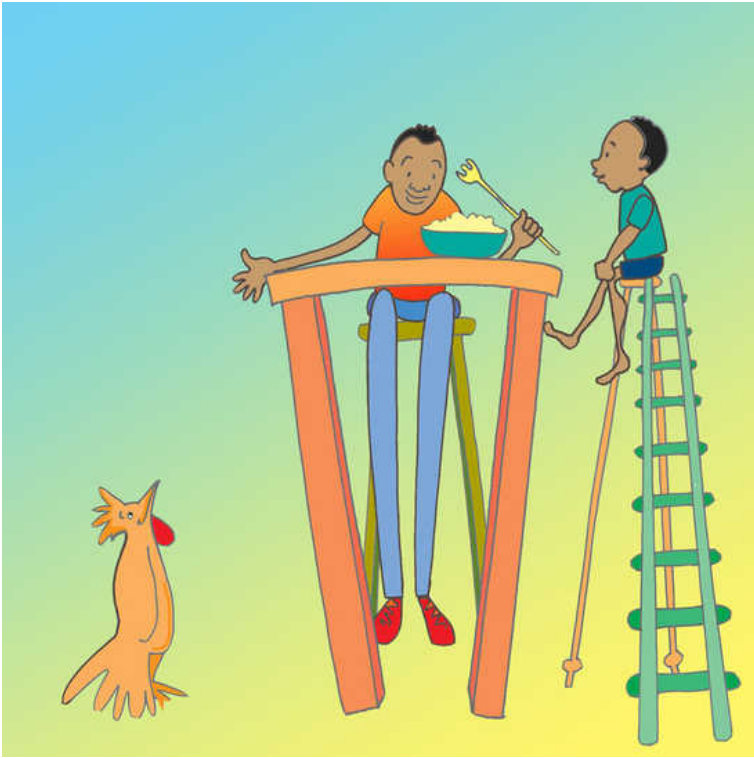
He made a very long bed.
