...

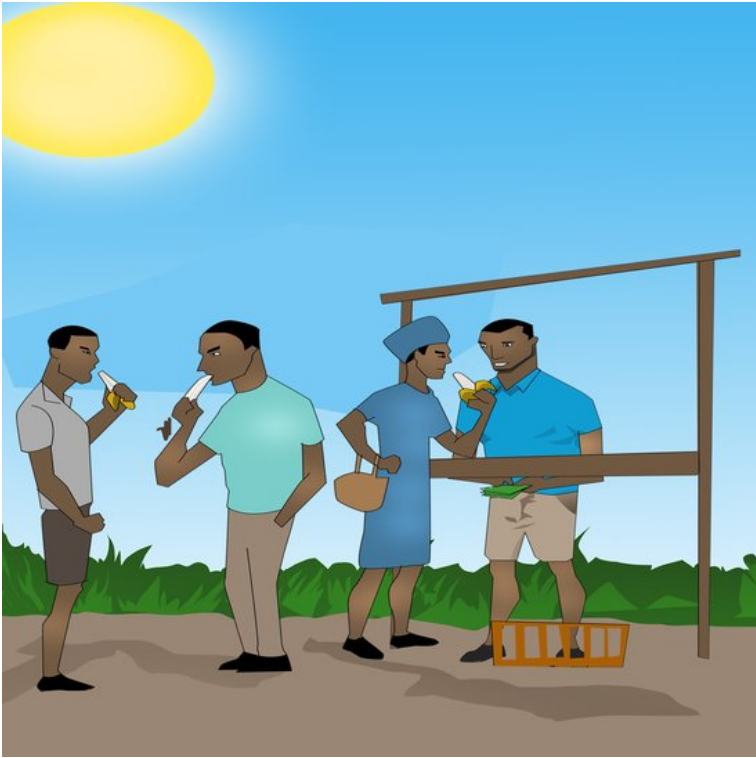
The woman buys the bananas.
