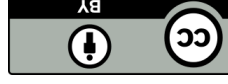

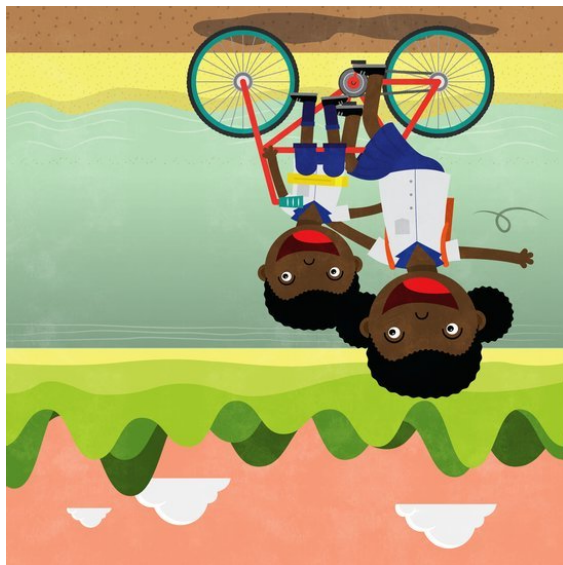

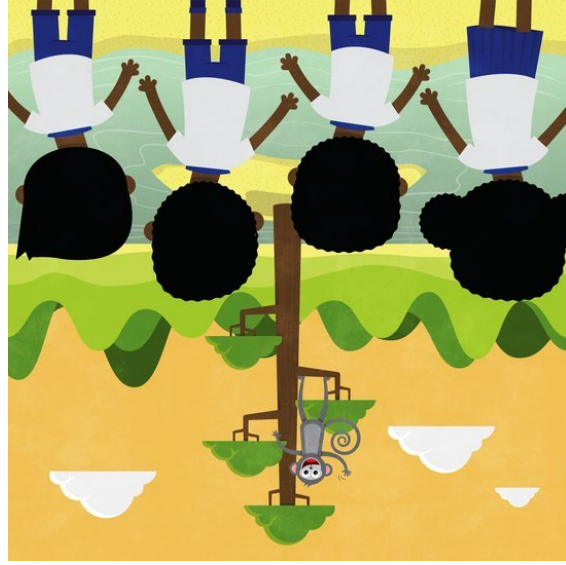
While they are in the classroom, a monkey

the lake. He climbs high into a tree.

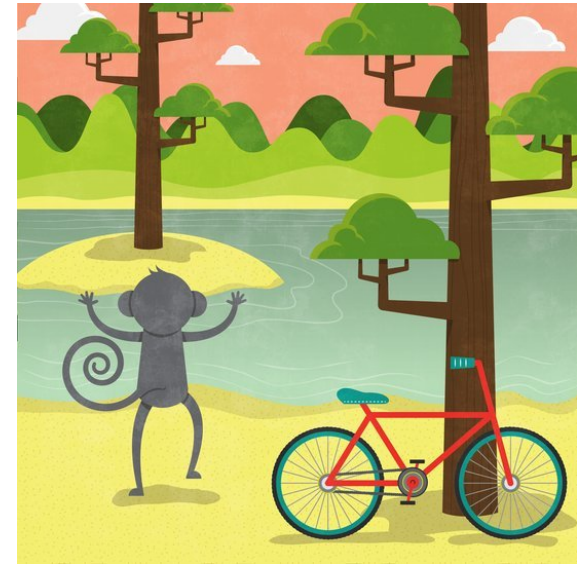




Barutwana ba ne ba leleka tshwene.
