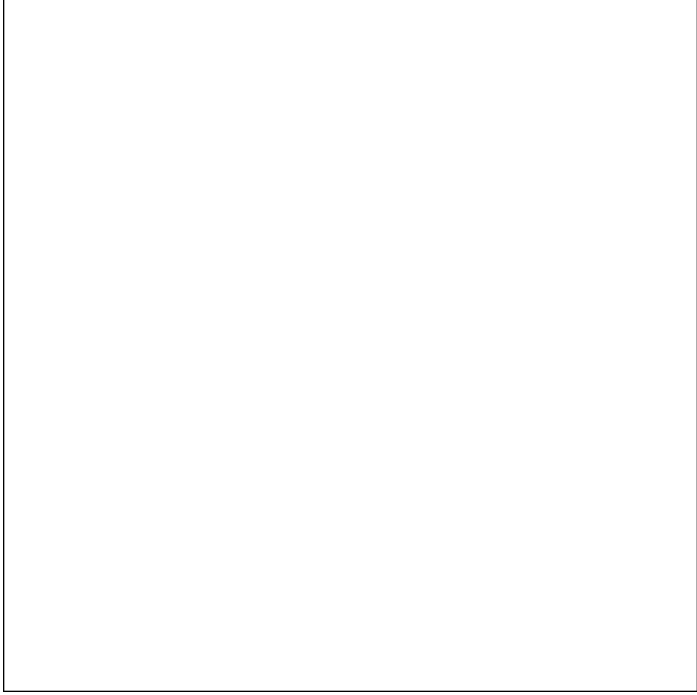

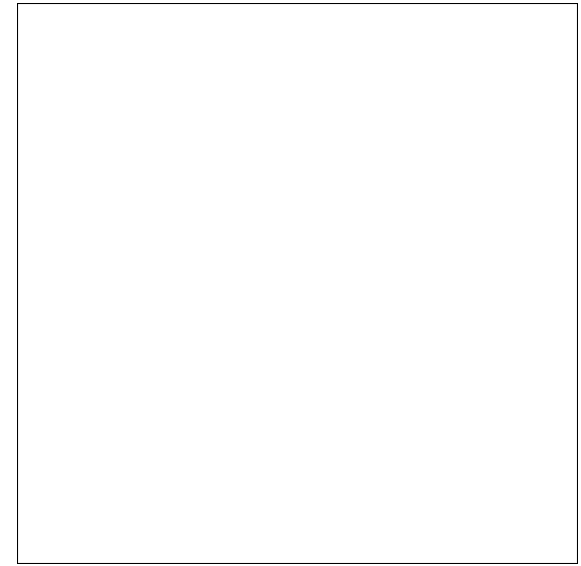
Agnes uses crutches to walk.

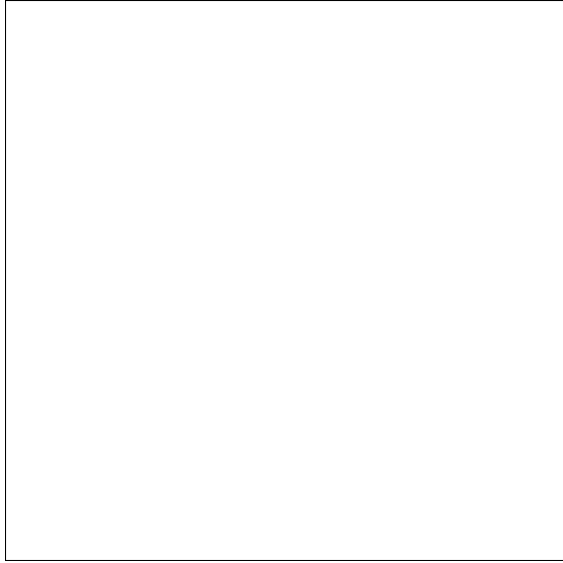
Osero has no hands. But he scores many goals for our team!

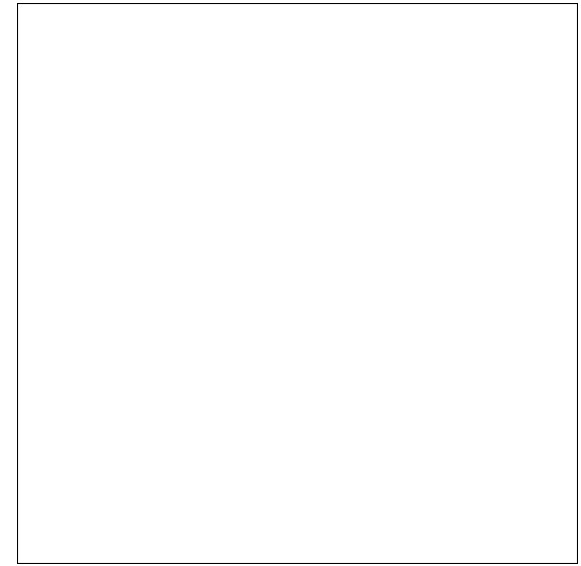
This is Osero. He is the best soccer player at my school.
