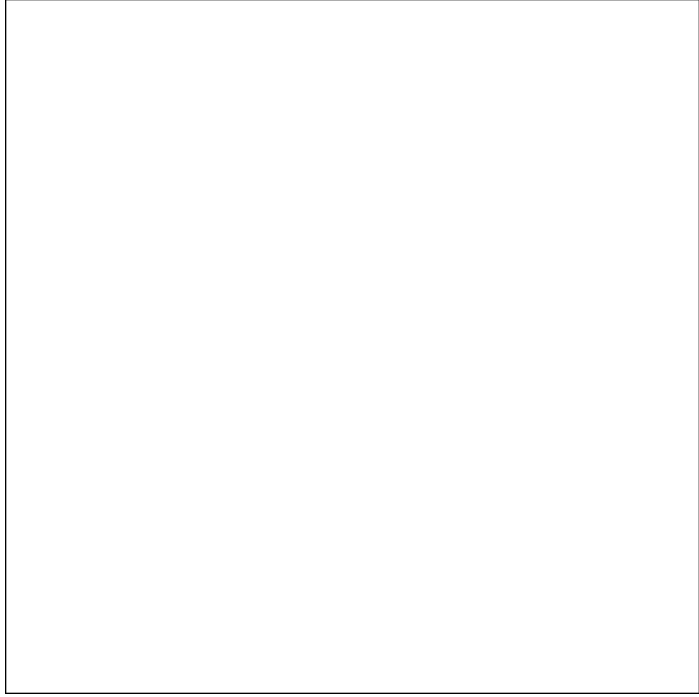

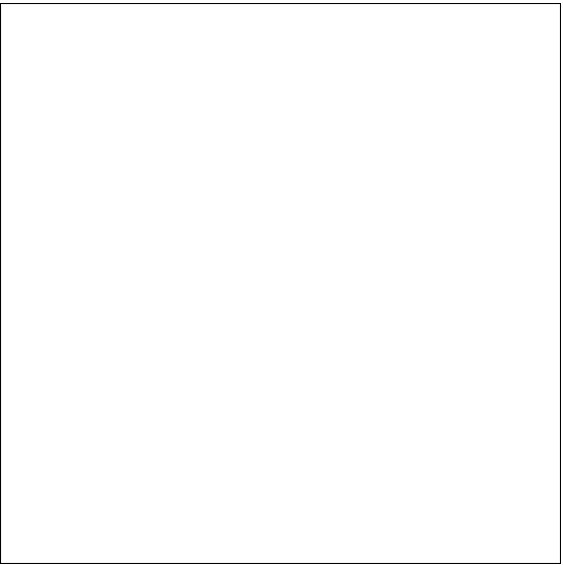

Osego ga a na diatla. Mme o nosetsa setlhopha sa rona dinno di le dintsi!

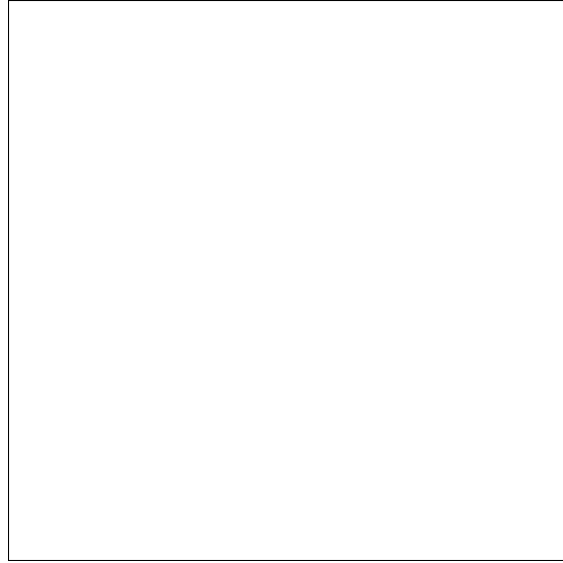

This is Osero. He is the best soccer player at my school.

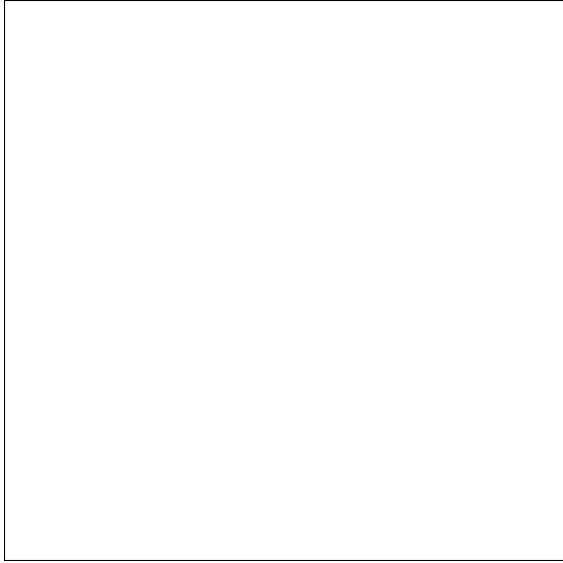
