1.2. A three-quarters (75%) majority approval is granted by the Senate and the House of Representatives.”

1.2. The club is able to collect at least ten (10) signatures from club members advocating for its association status as well as a signature from the staff advisor confirming the validity of such signatures.

1.3. The Senate or House of Representatives can find no justifiable reason why the club is not deserving of association status.

1.3.1. Reasons that are not considered justifiable include, but are not limited to concerns over funding needs or concerns that Article VII Sections 1.1. and 1.2. address, such as membership or school presence.

1.3.2. As well, the club applying for association status may have, should they choose, up to two (2) representatives attending the Senate and/or House of Representatives meeting to respond to any hesitations regarding their status change or to provide additional reasoning, so long as they are respectful and timely.

1.4. The club is passed, meaning they become an association with at least two-thirds (67%) in the Executive and at least three-quarters (75%) in both the Senate and House of Representatives, based on whether each group feels all the previous conditions have been met.”

*These conditions on association status were created as a result of surveying the Senate, as well as substantial internal debate*

**Article VII s. 2**

“SAC fund eligibility is not limited for associations”

“Associations are entitled to request an unlimited amount of funds from the SAC”

**Article VII s. 5**

“Association status can be revoked with a three-quarters (75%) majority vote from the Senate and the House of Representatives.”
